Satellite Camp Information

Friday 19th July to Monday 22nd 2024

The Blair Atholl Jamborette offers a fantastic opportunity for Scottish Scouts to camp with Scouts from many different countries and to take part in a truly unique international event.

The purpose of the Satellite Camp at Blair Atholl is to enable Scottish Scouts to get a short taste of International Scouting at the Jamborette. The Satellite Camp programme is **aimed primarily at members of the Scout Section** and Patrols or Troops are welcome.

Applications from Explorer Scout Units are also welcome. We regret that Beavers or Cub Scouts cannot be accepted as participants, however, younger children of Leaders attending may be brought to the satellite camp. Please advise of this on your application.

Dates

The Satellite Camp runs from noon on Friday 19th July to noon on Monday 22nd July 2024. This is the middle weekend of the Jamborette including Visitors' Day and Scouts' Own.

Cost

The cost of attending is £60.00 per person. **Please note that no payment should be made until places have been formally allocated and confirmed.**

Facilities

Toilet facilities and water points are provided. Campers must be self-sufficient in tentage, catering (with the exception of Sunday evening meal), First Aid etc.

Please note that space is not available for caravans, campervans etc. (Reservations for these can be made with Blair Atholl Caravan Site separately.)

Programme

There is a programme of activities on offer designed to assist campers to integrate and enjoy the international atmosphere of the Jamborette. On Friday afternoon and evening there are integration and orientation activities. On Saturday there are activities in the morning, an opportunity to participate in the Country Fair during the afternoon and the Jamborette's International campfire in the evening. The Sunday programme includes Scouts' Own, International Games, an evening BBQ on the main camp and evening entertainment. In 2024 there's even greater integration with the main camp.

Leaders / Adults

During the Satellite Camp, Leaders are expected to assist with the various planned activities. **Please note that there should be an appropriate, not excessive, ratio of adults to young people.**

It should be noted that all adult applicants must have a current Protection of Vulnerable Groups Certificate secured through Scouting and these will be checked prior to the event. **Any adult without this will not be allowed to attend the Satellite Camp. All adults volunteers will require to have valid training as determined by their role.**

Full details on obtaining a PVG Certificate through Scouting can be provided by your District Commissioner or District Appointments Secretary.

Application Process

Because the Satellite Camp is very popular and often oversubscribed we have a ballot system for applications.

- The application process will open on **Monday 19th February 2024**. With a closing date of **Thursday 14th March 2024**.
- Forms are completed online at <http://bit.ly/BA2024-Satellite>
- Once you have completed your form and submitted it we will contact your District Commissioner and get their approval for your group to attend the Satellite Camp.
- No applications will be accepted after the closing date of **Thursday 14th March 2024**.
- After the closing date all applications received will enter the ballot and places will be allocated at this time. This ensures that Scouts from all over Scotland have an **equal opportunity** to attend this camp.
- All applicants, successful and unsuccessful, will be notified by email no later than the **22th Mar 2024**.

As no deposit is required with the form, it should not be collected from the young people at this stage and it is absolutely crucial that you **do not inform Scouts they are going to Satellite Camp until you have had emailed confirmation from the camp admin team that you have been allocated places.**
